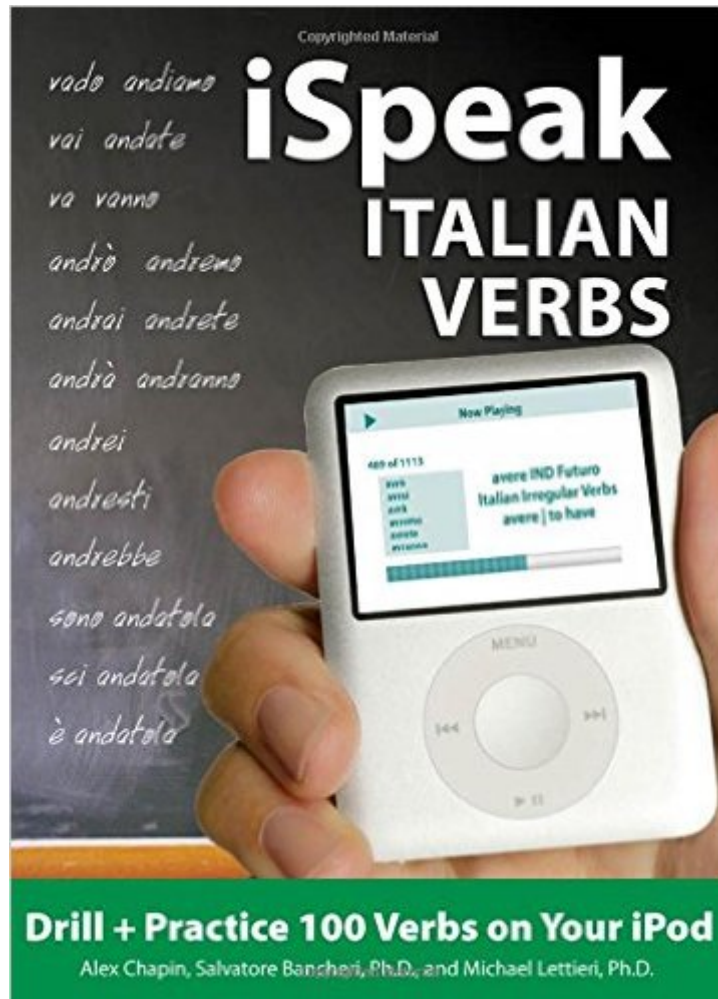

While getting by in Italian is pretty easy, if you really want to master it, eventually you run up against their complicated verbs: There are many tenses - some a lot of Italians don't even use - and many, many, many irregular verbs. FYI, the Italians are very proud of both how difficult their language is at the higher levels, and how many years of schooling they spend to conquer it. After finishing an introductory college level textbook in Italian, my head was absolutely swimming with tenses and conjugations and I'm SO HAPPY to have found this product. As others mentioned, it's just a guy

reciting conjugations. Yay! I'm an auditory learner, so it's perfect for me. They're correctly pronounced, and in the compound tenses, the speaker goes through all the permutations affected by gender. And he speaks pretty quickly, which is also GREAT! It'll save me time writing out flash cards, which I kept putting off, and lock these darn things in my brain. Only downside: They don't do the Passato Remoto or the Imperfetto e Congiuntivo - two tenses I've been struggling with - darn it! While iSpeak Italian Verbs could be helpful to a beginning student, it is a SUPPLEMENTAL resource, not the place to start for a beginner... and make a playlist then only with the basic verbs you need in the tenses you understand how to use. I'm a big, big fan of Michel Thomas's Italian CDs. If you want to learn for a holiday, start there.

This is not a bad product, but it uses the traditional approach of drill and kill. We do learn from repetition but sometimes the drill can be so boring it kills our incentive to learn. The audio quality of the speaker and information presented is good. That said, learning all the multitude of Italian verb forms require extraordinary methods for those of us learning Italian as a second language and not exposed to it in our daily environment. There is no easy way to get this knowledge. For those who are not bored to death by drill, this product will be useful for learning the complex Italian verbs system.

No accompanying music. No tricks. Just a lot of extraordinary content. You'll still need to do the work but this is outstanding value for money.

This product is a waste of money and time. All it is is someone reciting verbs with no context apart from someone stating in the beginning the infinitive eg. to speak. I recommend you rather add the \$10 to the cost of purchasing a Michel Thomas Italian CD
