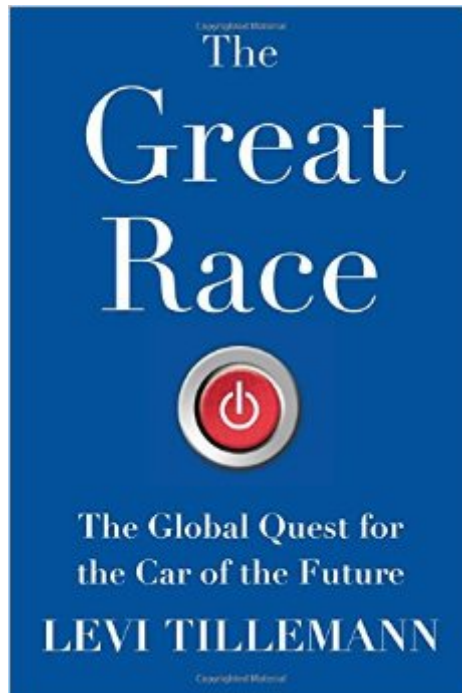

• The Great Race • is a great book, no pun intended. But, there a couple of caveats.
